RE-ENROLMENT 2007-2008

Dear Parents,

Creative Intelligence is what matters! Our pedagogy aims to help children develop into confident individuals, who are responsible, can make decisions and interact well with others. By using both the left and the right side of the brain, they practise divergent thinking. This gives the ability to integrate knowledge, and become creative and innovative. The children have ownership of their development and therefore become motivated learners! This set of abilities matters in a changing world!

Learning other languages in a holistic manner is nearly a must these days. Children in a full time bilingual setting combined with the Montessori advantages have the opportunity to apply their talents within different cultural and multi language settings.

Due to our success and good reputation, the school works with waiting lists. In the past this was only at the level of Toddler Community and Children's House, but now it is also applicable at the Primary level. Places in Middle School are limited since we want to continue to offer the International Baccalaureate program centered around responsibility, social commitment and adaptability by means of personalised mentorship and real life experiences.

Re-enrolment is open now to every family in the school and you can confirm your commitment by transferring the re-enrolment fee to the school's bank account. The date the school receives this fee determines the order of enrolment. Please also hand in the enclosed re-enrolment form(s).

The re-enrolment fee is €400 for Toddlers and Children's House children and €600 for Primary and Middle School children. This re-enrolment fee is deducted from the Tuition Fees for the 07-08 school year and non-refundable in the event of the child not taking up the place.

The school has Standard Tuition Fees but is committed to continuing to offer the reduced fees for Families who do not receive financial help from their respective companies. We are proud to say that we have managed to keep these Parent Paid Fees as one of the lowest tuition fees of private schools in Brussels!

Your family has priority over new families wishing to join the school during the re-enrolment period which ends on March 21, 2007.

During the re-enrolment period, places are allocated as follows:

- 1) Children re-enrolling into their own class and children moving to the subsequent age level in their own location or to the Primary or Middle School level.
- 2) Siblings
- 3) Requests for transfer of Toddlers and Children's House children to an other location: Please note that these transfers cannot be guaranteed and depend on vacancies available after re-enrolment mentioned under 1 and 2.
When places are available, transferring children are given a place by order of re-enrolment.
- 4) From March 21, 2007 onwards new enrolments and further re-enrolments will be accepted in the order of enrolment.
