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# International Montessori School 'Hof Kleinenberg'

Kleinenbergstraat 97-99  
1932 Sint-Stevens-Woluwe

A historic rectangular farmhouse dating back to 1651, situated in a green environment to children aged 2 1/2 to 11 and secondary students up to 18 years old.

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'Hof Kleinenberg' served as a farm for 357 years until it was completely renovated and restored to its former grandeur in 2008. It now includes several optimal learning environments catering to the developmental and academic needs of children and older students alike. It also houses a 'historic' school library, science laboratory and a multi-functional space used for visual arts, theatre, music and special events such as markets, concerts and exhibitions.

The rectangular building, centred around a courtyard, houses an international community where the emphasis is on respect and responsibility. The children in Preschool and Primary are in bilingual learning environments and the older students work at a multilingual level. The individualised approach ensures that different learning styles are acknowledged and students have the opportunity to develop their personal strengths and challenges.

The Diploma Programme students, being the oldest ones, work towards the final International Baccalaureate examinations and can then enter universities worldwide. Due to the small-scale setting, they receive personalised mentorship.

The outdoor grounds are extensive. The children have interesting equipment to play on, with the older students having their multi-sport facility that includes a giant chessboard. Vegetable gardens and flowerbeds provide outdoor work opportunities whilst the fields in the valley are used by our resident ponies, Pipo and Choco. Since the farm is situated on a small mountain named 'Kleinenberg', the children can 'zoom down' on the flying fox!

The After School Hour Programme is available every day up to 18:00 and caters to a large group of children joining in different workshops such as language learning, circus, cooking, art and craft.

Parking facilities ensures efficient drop off both sides of the building. Door to door school bus service is available and the Secondary students can use public transport with a bus stop very close to school.
